 - Each space will be numbered for easy identification
 - Vendors should be ready to move in at 5:00pm
 - All vehicles will need to be out of the vending area before 5:30pm
- Vendors will need to begin moving out at 9:00pm with all vendors vacated before the road re-opens at 9:30pm
 - The Town of Manchester seasonal/annual vending fee will be waived for this event

- 5K Fun Run at 9:30am begins and ends at the Dana L. Thompson Memorial Park
 - Registration from 8:00am-9:00am \$15 pre \$20 post \$10 No Tee Shirt Option
 - Tee shirt to the first 100
- The Parks and Recreation pool will be open from 10:00am-4:00pm for all to enjoy at no charge – Game and activities all day
 - There will be live entertainment on the Town Green from 5:30pm-9:00pm
 - Two bands and roaming entertainment
 - Depot Street will be closed from Cottage Street to Main Street
 - Vendors will be set-up on Depot Street from 5:30pm-9:00pm
 - Fireworks are scheduled for 9:30pm at the Dana L. Thompson Memorial Park
- Parking at the Dana L. Thompson Memorial Park will be limited to paved areas only – THERE WILL BE NO PARKING ON THE FIELDS OR GRASS!
